Madanyat is a Lebanese Non-Governmental Organization, registered in March 2019, under the number 2389, aiming to respond effectively to the social change occurring in the country, believing that a diversity of voices will lead to a fairer, and more inclusive and democratic society.

Madanyat has a stable structure with involved board members, a President, Nada Saleh Anid/expert in gender equality issues, a Secretary, Georges Nehmé/lawyer, and a Treasurer, Martine Tchopourian/financial expert, periodically updated on the advancement of the programs, and a young and dedicated team with specific job descriptions.

Madanyat doesn't have a membership system, but relies on a wide network formed by beneficiaries and focal points from all Lebanese regions.

Number of Beneficiaries

Since 2019 till today, Madanyat has worked with a total of 1500 direct beneficiaries, 2168298 indirect beneficiaries and 8913629 through Social Media outreach from different areas. Beneficiaries were outreached by Madanyat's field officers and/or partners, social media announcements and by referrals.


Madanyat's ensures an inclusive environment during the implementation of its projects.



SOME OF OUR KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

Youth Vote

80% of the youth enhanced their knowledge in the Lebanese electoral law, gender equality in politics and accountability due to the training sessions with 1,074,884 social media users were reached through organic and paid media.


Me Too /Sawtna

In the first project recommendations report was launched with details on how to fight VAWP. In the second report, multiple videos featured key figures in politics to highlight their experiences in violence against women in politics.

These projects aimed to raise awareness on Violence Against Women in Politics and on its detrimental effects at all levels of the electoral process, while contributing to institutional capacity building of Supervisory Committee for Elections.

Revive

The women designed and led a need assessment for their areas and implemented 6 initiatives based on these needs while working with multiple stakeholders from municipalities and NGOs. Developed two women committees in vulnerable areas in Mount Lebanon: trained and coached them to be active in their communities. Created a needs assessment through participatory methods and supported the women in implementing their initiatives.









SOME OF OUR KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

Moubadirat/ We Go Public

30 videos launched online to highlight the women's projects.

wo projects to support women and their initiatives through training sessions for 30 women to coach them on how to move forward with their initiatives and how to transform them into policies if possible.

Youth Matters

70% of the youth enhanced their knowledge in politics and the role of the Lebanese women in this matter, in addition to the importance of voting and policymaking. 5 dissemination events were implemented


Strengthened the political and legislative knowledge of 20 youth in Lebanon through training sessions, along with supporting the youth facilitating dissemination events to reach a broader audience.

Women In Politics: Delving into women empowerment, perceptions and attitudes

Engaged women experts in politics in addition to youth and other Lebanese groups in the research and reached a sample of 1000 Lebanese persons. Developed qualitative and quantitative research to understand the perspective of Lebanese people and their attitudes of women in politics. Produced a full report of the results along with animated videos for social media.

La Tribune

Increased the knowledge of 40 youth on issues related to women's rights in Lebanon and with enhanced skills of public speaking and debating.
